D. City Secretary-Pat Patterson (activities and information): The new culvert alongside FM 274 will cost \$3500 not counting paying to have it put in. TXDOT will not put it in for us because it is going into a private property and is not a street. Received the permit with the blue prints on how it is to be installed.

Paid the fees for the quarter of July, August and September which was \$153.50.

Renew the Quicken Subscription at \$89.50.

Daniel Sparks was hired to clear the fallen branches and haul away on Elm St. He charged us \$1299.00. A good job was done especially since no one else could do it.

Suzy Weeks called and left a message to confirm if we needed one or two 30-yrd roll-offs for the 20<sup>th</sup>. It was confirmed and I wrote a check and dropped it in the mail. Payment was \$1350 and had to be paid before the weekend of event. There was an ad placed in the Paper of Record stating the requirements and what could be and could not be brought in to dump.

Had a gentleman looking to buy bulk water so that the drainage ditches could be cleaned out. I gave him Lance Capeharts number so that Lance might be able to help him.
